Work is a mix of remote, in-office, and on-site in community and public spaces. Candidate must be willing to travel within the GTHA and work in the evenings and weekends.

**Notes:** Position involves travel within the GTHA and work on evenings and weekends. Candidates should also be comfortable spending time outdoors in public spaces doing light to moderate physical activity including walking, bicycling, and lifting pop-up placemaking materials.

### **Job Description:**

The Summer Project Intern will support our various projects, programs, and initiatives related to our mission to ignite action and challenge the status quo to create healthier, more equitable, and sustainable cities for all people. Under the supervision of our Directors and Project Managers, the Summer Project Intern will be responsible for supporting community engagement processes, rapid prototyping in public space, coordinating public events, analyzing engagement data, and developing eye-catching communications materials and data visualizations.
